

Minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board, of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, January 5, 1928 at 2 P. M.

The Meeting was called to order by Town Clerk Burns, and on motion duly made, seconded and carried, Justice Burnside was elected temporary Chairman of the Board.

Justice Burnside, temporary Chairman of the Board called for the nomination of the Chairman of the Town Board and on motion and vote Supervisor Homan was unanimously elected Chairman of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, held December 29, 1927 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

A communication from Russell E. Griffin of South Jamesport applying for the position of motorcycle officer was read.

Petitions was additional street lights, one at the junction of Fishel Avenue and Main Street, Riverhead, and one on Cemetery Avenue, near St. Isidors Church were presented.

Supervisor Homan appointed Justice Robert Burnside and Justice Albert W. Conklin, a committee on street lighting and the Petitions as above noted were referred to this committee to investigate and to report back to the Town Board.

The Petition, of the Lions Club, to limit the hours of parking, in the business section of Riverhead, was next brought before the Board, and on motion and vote, said Petition was referred to counsel, to ascertain the powers of the Town Board, to regulate the hours of parking.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was Resolved that the Highway Allowance of the Supervisor under Section 110 of the Highway Law be and the same is hereby

fixed at \$900.00 per annum.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Highway Allowance of the Town Clerk under Section 110 of the Highway Law, be and the same hereby is fixed at \$150.00 per annum.

Supervisor Homan advised the Board of the appointment of Julian Rubenstein, as Clerk to the Supervisor and requested that the compensation of the Clerk to the Supervisor be fixed at this time.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was Resolved that the compensation of Julian Rubenstein, as Clerk to the Supervisor be and the same hereby is fixed at \$1500.00 per year.

Justice Conklin brought the matter of establishing a Gabage District within the Village of Riverhead, before the Board and recommended that steps be taken to establish such a district.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the matter of establishing a Gabage District within the Village of Riverhead, be referred to counsel to ascertain the proper procedure necessary to establish such a district.

There being no further business, the Meeting adjourned, to meet on January 19, 1928 at 2 P. M.
