

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday July 26th, 1918 at 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried Jos. W. Kratoville was appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics for a term ending Jan. 1st, 1922.

The report of Sydney W. Reeve Overseer of the Poor was presented and on motion seconded and carried same was approved and ordered sent to County Superintendent of the Poor.

On motion seconded and carried Supervisor Howell was authorized to transfer the sum of \$32.75 from the Dog Fund to the Contingent Fund.

On motion seconded and carried the following resolution was passed.

RESOLVED, that lights upon motor vehicles, when standing upon the portions of the highways of the Town of Riverhead hereinafter mentioned as zones A, B and C, and not in motion during the period from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise, be and the same hereby are dispensed with.

ZONE A Beginning at the easterly line of the premises owned by Edwin D. Fishel on Main Street in the Village and Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk and State of New York, and extending westerly therefrom along Main Street aforesaid to a point one hundred feet west of the intersection of the westerly line of Griffing Avenue with said Main Street.

ZONE B Beginning at the intersection of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street aforesaid and extending northerly therefrom along said Roanoke Avenue to the intersection of the southerly line of First Street with said Roanoke Avenue.

ZONE C Beginning at the intersection of Peconic Avenue and Main Street aforesaid and running thence southerly along said Peconic Avenue to the division line between the Towns of Riverhead and Spouthampton.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
