

The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Thursday August 10, 1893 at 1 P.M.

All members present.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The Town Clerk made a report as to the prices paid by several towns and corporations for lighting by oil lamps.

After considerable discussion as to the best means of lighting the district at the limited sum of \$1000# per annum the Supervisor was, on motion, appointed a Committee to lay the matter of furnishing lamps before the Village Improvement Society, to further the end of using the whole of the \$1000# merely for the operation of the same.

On motion the Town Clerk was authorized to obtain sample lamps, Oil and Gasoline.

Meeting adjourned, subject to call of Supervisor.
