The Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Tuesday Sept. 5' 1893.

All members being present.

There being vacancies in the Office of Inspector of Elections in Dist. No. 2 and 3, Daniel A. Corwin and Daniel R. Young were appointed to fill such vacancies.

The following places were designated as election places in said town.

Dist. No. 1	Wading River Hall
" " 2	Town Hall
" " 3	Riverhead Hall
" " 4	Harmony Hall.

The matter of licensing Public Hacks and Vehicles was brought up and the following Act was adopted.

"An act to license and regulate Public Hacks and Vehicles in the Town of Riverhead.

The authority to pass this resolution is found in Chapter 332 of the laws of 1890.

SEC. I. On and after the 5th day of September 1893 it shall not be lawful to drive any public hack or other public vehicle in the town of Riverhead until a license therefor has been obtained from said Town Board.

SEC. II. Such license to expire Sept. 1, 1894 will be granted on payment of a fee of Ten (\$10.) Dollars to the Town Clerk of said Town.

SEC. III. Any person violating the provisions of Sec. I of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a penalty of Twenty-five (\$25.) Dollars.
