

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Wednesday June 23, 1915 at 3:30 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion Supervisor, Dwight T. Corwin was appointed a committee to purchase a suitable Safe Cabinet for the Board of Assessors at a price not to exceed \$100.00.

On motion the following ordinance was adopted and ordered published twice in the Riverhead News and County Review.

NOTICE

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 137, Section 1, of the Laws of 1915, in effect March 30, 1915, in relation to the powers of Town Boards, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk and State of New York, at a regular meeting of said Board, held at the Town Clerk's office of said town on the 2d day of June, 1915, does hereby enact the following ordinance:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons owning or harboring a dog or dogs within the limits of the town of Riverhead, to permit or allow such dog or dogs, so owned or harbored, to run at large in said town on the streets, sidewalks or public places thereof, or on any property or premises other than those of the owner or harborer of such dog or dogs (unless such dog or dogs are actually engaged in hunting, during the hunting season, in charge and under control of a person of mature age), unless such dog or dogs shall be accompanied by a person of mature age and discretion.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of not more than fifty dollars for each violation to be sued for and recovered in the name of the town of Riverhead, before any Justice Court of said town upon complaint of any person and upon conviction of a violation of this ordinance and a default or failure to pay such fine or penalty as may be imposed such person or persons so convicted shall be imprisoned in the County Jail for a term not exceeding one day for each and every dollar of such a fine or penalty as may be imposed by said Justice or Justice Court, for a violation hereof.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be published in the Riverhead News and County Review hereby and for the purpose of publication of this ordinance designated as official papers, once a week for two weeks following the date of the adoption of this ordinance, the first publication thereof to be on the 4th day of June, 1915, and the last publication thereof to be on the 11th day of June, 1915.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect on the 22d day of June, 1915, ten days after the date of said publication.
