

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 23, 1935 at 9:00 A.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 2, 1935 and minutes of the Budget Hearing were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A receipt from the County Clerk for the filing of the oath of office and bond for Daniel J. Roche was presented to the Board and ordered placed on file.

A communication from the Riverhead Garden Club calling to the attention of the Board the untidiness of the streets and yards of the Town due to the indiscriminate distribution of "hand bills" or "dodgers" and requested that the Town Board take some action on the matter.

On motion made by Justice Stackpole and seconded by Justice Rubenstein it was RESOLVED by unanimous consent that the Town Attorney be and he hereby is directed to draft an ordinance, prohibiting the placing of hand bills or dodgers on porches, yards or cars in the Town of Riverhead.

On motion made by Justice Luce and seconded by Justice Stackpole, it was RESOLVED that the following Annual Estimate of revenues and expenditures for the year of 1936 be and the same hereby is adopted.

The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes, Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town and Welfare bills for the month of October, 1935.

The Town Clerk presented a list of Water Rents due to June 30, 1935, on motion and vote it was Resolved by unanimous consent that the Clerk be and he hereby is directed to file a copy in his office and the original be given to the Supervisor to be levied in the next Taxes.

On motion made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by Justice Hallock it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay the Welfare bills for the month of October as approved by the Welfare Officer. The vote, Justices Stackpole, Rubenstein, Luce and Hallock, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by Justice Hallock, it was RESOLVED by unanimous consent that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to transfer the sum of \$25.00 from the Surplus account to the Municipal Indebtedness Account.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned till Wednesday, November 13, 1935 at 9:00 A. M.
