On motion Lorimer M. Raynor was appointed Attendance Officer in and for the Town of Riverhead at \$2.00 per day for each and every day's actual services and 5 cents per mile mileage.

On motion the following ordinance was adopted:

An act to license and regulate circuses, shows, venders, etc. in the Town of Riverhead.

The authority to pass this resolution is found in Chapter 332 of the laws of 1890.

Sec. 1. On and after the 16th day of September it shall not be lawful for any traveling circus or show to exhibit or parade in the Town of Riverhead until a license has been obtained from the Town Board.

Sec. 2. Such license to expire on midnight on the day for which such license is issued will be granted on payment

of such fee as three members of the Town Board shall deem just and proper.

Sec. 3. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and sha,, be liable to a penalty of twenty-five (\$25) dollars.

Clerk was instructed to have this ordinance published in the local papers for four weeks.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
