

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the office of Justice Hildreth Friday afternoon, Nov. 13, 1908 at 1 o'clock.

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Howell and Board proceeded to audit accounts against the town.

On motion the Justices were appointed a committee on Constables and Sheriff's bills and the whole Board acted on the rest of the bills, but no member had a voice in the auditing of his own bill.

Bills amounting to \$764.41 and Board of Health bills amounting to \$367.15 were audited and allowed.

Overseer of the Poor Terry presented his semi-annual report, which was duly examined and found to be correct.

A petition was presented praying for a street light to be placed on the corner of East and Grand streets and on motion the Supervisor was instructed to see that a light is placed there.
