Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 19, 1942 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Mrs Helen Hallock Reeve thanking the Board for delegating her to write a book and compose a pageant to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the formation of the Town of Riverhead. The communication was ordered placed on file.


A Police report for the month of August 1942 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered place on file.

A communication was read from Town Attorney Seth A. Hubbard in regard to voting on the Meeting House Creek dredging project. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Warner it was resolved that Bond No. S-151679 of the Century Indemnity Company bonding Joseph J. Ruskowski as Justice of the Peace in the amount of \$1,000.00 be and the same is hereby approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the bills of the Town for the month of August 1942.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 23, 1942 at 2:00 P.M.
