Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion it was ordered that the Board recommend to Supervisor and two Justices the appointment of a Special Constable for duty in Village of Riverhead for a period of sixty days, and to be on duty every day during the week from 1:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. except Saturdays when he shall serve from 1:00 P.M. to 11:30 P.M. The compensation to be \$3.00 per day.

On motion it was ordered that the Town Clerk be paid for his services in carrying out provisions of Election Law a fee of \$4.00 per day except when required to travel out of the Village of Riverhead in order to carry out his duties under the Election Law and in such instances he to receive a fee of \$7.00 per days

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
