

On motion seconded and carried, B. Frank Howell was  
authorized to have five Special Deputy Sheriffs appointed  
to act during the Fair; each Special Deputy Sheriff to  
receive a compensation of \$3.00 per day.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that  
all Hacks, Motor Buses or Jitneys operating in Riverhead  
during period from Sept. 16th, 1918 to Sept. 21st, 1918  
inclusive be required to pay license fees of \$10.00 for  
each Bus with a capacity of ten or more passengers and  
\$5.00 for each Bus with a capacity of less than 10  
passengers.
