

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, April 26, 1928 at 2 P.M.

Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways was present.

The minutes of the Meeting of the Town Board, held March 28, 1928 were read and on motion and vote, duly adopted.

Justice Burnside and Town Clerk Burns, the committee appointed by Supervisor Homan, to officiate at the Water District Election, held April 6, 1928, presented a Statement of the Canvass of said Election.

Hubert F. Corwin, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Water Commissioner for a term of three years from April 16, 1928.

George E. Luce, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Water Commissioner for a term of two years from April 16, 1928.

Ellis S. Duvall, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Water Commissioner for a term of one year from April 16, 1928.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the findings of the committee in charge of the Water District Election held April 6, 1928 be approved.

Bonds were presented, bonding Water Commissioners Hubert F. Corwin, George E. Luce and Ellis S. Duvall and on motion duly made, seconded and carried, it is hereby Resolved that the Bonds of Water Commissioners Hubert F. Corwin, George E. Luce and Ellis S. Duvall be hereby approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the sureties.

The application of Daniel R. Young for a highway connecting Raynor Avenue and Hamilton Avenue was brought before the Board and Halsey Reeve addressed the Board

requesting that application be granted. Application was referred to Town Superintendent Charles O. Downs for investigation.

Mr. John Dombek, addressed the Board, complaining of the parking of automobiles in front of the driveway leading into his property on Peconic Avenue.

The Board recommended that the Town cause to have painted on the highway in front of the driveway of John Dombek, the words "NO PARKING- DRIVEWAY".

R. C. Smith, representing the American Legion, addressed the Board and requested that some action be taken by the Board in regard to erecting street signs and numbering houses and lots as per authority now vested in the Town Board under Section 190 of the laws of 1928.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that Daniel R. Young be and he is hereby authorized to make the necessary survey of the Town designating the numbers of lots and houses in order to comply with the regulations of the Post Office Department for city delivery service.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the street signs and posts complete as offered by C. F. McCullough of 15 Chatsworth Avenue, Larchmont, N.Y. be and they are hereby adopted for the Town of Riverhead.

Allison L. Young of Northville, addressed the Board and requested that the Incorporated Village of Northville be allowed the use of the Town Tractor and Road Breaker to break up about 12 miles of highway in said village.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Incorporated Village of Northville be allowed the use of the Town Tractor and Road Breaker for breaking up about 12 miles of highway, said tractor and road breaker to be returned to the Town in the same condition as when taken.

Charles O. Downs, Town Supt. of Highways addressed the Board, in regard to road oil and asked the opinion of the Board as to whether to put the purchase of road oil out to bids or to purchase same in the open market.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the road oil necessary for the Town of Riverhead, in the open market at the best price obtainable.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the chair.
