

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that the  
following Parking Zone be established in the Village of  
Riverhead, and that Vehicles, Cars and Motor Vehicles while  
parked and stationary are not required to show lights to  
be visible from front and rear from one hour after sunset  
to one hour before sunrise. Said Parking Zone being  
described as follows:

Begins at the residence of Edwin D. Fishel  
and extends westerly on both sides of Main Street to the  
residence of Judge T. M. Griffing, extends down Peconic  
Ave. and up Roanoke Ave. (one the east side only) to First  
Street except that a "Landing Place" is to be kept open on  
the north side of Main Street in a territory extending  
from Roanoke Avenue to S. Cavanaro's Store.
