Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.


This meeting was called at the request of Health Officer A. G. Terrell to discuss with the Physicians and Board of Education the situation as to the so called Spanish Influenza Epidemic.

Mr. E. W. Tooker and Mr. Geo. M. Vail representatives of the Board of Education of Riverhead School Dist. #5 stated that the Board of Education was not in favor of closing the Schools at this time. Mr. Earl B. Robinson, Principal of Riverhead High School expressed the same opinion.

Drs. Terrell and Payne both stated that they did not think it necessary or advisable to close the Schools at this time. Mr. George W. Hildreth stated that it was his opinion that the Schools should be closed at once.

Acting on the advise of the Health Officer the Board did not take any action regarding closing of Schools. It being agreed that the matter should properly be left to the discretion of the Health Officer.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
