

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office, Tuesday, Sept. 24th, 1923 at 7-30 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

At a meeting held August 9th, 1923 Mr. Arden S. Fredericks of Jamesport appeared before the Board and requested permission to cross the highway east of Washington Ave. at Jamesport to be used for the building of a siding by the N.Y. R.R. Co. and the request was granted.

At this meeting Mr. Fredericks appeared again and requested that a change be granted in the crossing of the highways and instead of crossing the highway east of Washington Ave. he asked permission to cross the highway known as Washington Ave. at Jamesport.

On motion made seconded and carried Mr. Fredericks was granted permission to cross Washington Ave. to be used for putting in a siding.

On motion made seconded and carried it was ordered to have the electric light on the corner of Hamilton and Osborne Avenues moved further up Osborne Avenue and one additional light placed on the corner of Sweezy and Osborne Avenues.

On motion made seconded and carried Justices Burnside and Young were appointed a committee to look over the lights in the different parts of the town and report at the next meeting.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor and Town Clerk were authorized to borrow the necessary amount of money to pay audited bills as of August 28th, 1923.

On motion made seconded and carried the Board rented the voting machine now in district No. 4 for the period of 1 year for the sum of \$ 75.00. Said machine to be used in the 4th. Election District of the Town. Supervisor and Town Clerk were authorized to sign agreements as prepared by the Voting Machine Co.

On motion made seconded and carried Louis C. Reeve was appointed Special Constable for a period of 30 days.

It was decided to hold the next meeting Sept. 7th. at 3-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
