

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 21st, 1942 at 2:00 P. M.

After the Board assembled and before the Meeting was called to order, Supervisor Kelly arose to the occasion and with pomp and solemnity announced that this date was the birthday of Justice Boutcher, where upon he was presented a birthday cake and candle, together with many useful though ornamental things. Congratulations were bestowed upon the Judge by all of the official family wishing him many more to come.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 7th, 1942 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the following sums of moneys from the Current Surplus Account to the following Accounts:


Miscellaneous Dog Warden Account	\$ 6.00

AND FURTHER RESOLVED that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$252.11 from the Police Salaries Account to the Police Department Expense Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's Report for the month of September, 1942 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Welfare bills for the month of September, 1942.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 28th, 1942 at 8:00 P. M.
