

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office, Wednesday Oct. 10th, 1923 at 7-30 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Mr. Robert P.Griffing and Mr. Ernest W.Tooker appeared before the Board and stated that the sign boards at the corner of Roanoke Avenue and Main Street and the glass case on the sidewalk in front of Mr. G.A.Ammans place of business were an obstruction in the highway and that some steps should be taken to have same removed.

On motion made seconded and carried this matter was referred to the Town Superintendent of Highways.

The opinion of Mr. Petty relative to the authority to accept gift as a public park was read and placed on file and Justice Robert Burnside was appointed a committee to have a search made of the title of the land donated to the town by Cora B.Reeves.Barnes.

On motion made seconded and carried Justice Young was appointed a committee to interview Mr. Harold Robinson in regards to the highway to the public park.

On motion made seconded and carried that the matter of rebate to the Village of Sound Avenue in connection with the second issue of Town bonds be referred to counsel for an opinion.

A tentative budget for electric lights was fixed at \$ 4700.00.

On motion made seconded and carried it is resolved that the following propositions be submitted at the next general election to be held November 6th, 1923.

- No. 1. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$500.00 for the Contingent Fund?"
- No. 2. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$1000.00 for the Board of Health Fund?"
- No. 3. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$1500.00 for the Overseer of the Poor Fund?"
- X No. 4. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$50.00 for the proper observance of Memorial Day; said sum to be payable to the Commander of Henry A. Barnum Post, G. A. R., Riverhead, New York?"
- X No. 5. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$96.00 for the payment of the rent of the post rooms of Henry A. Barnum Post, G. A. R., Riverhead, New York?"
- X No. 6. "Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1924 and 1925, the sum of \$150.00 for the purpose of contributing said amount to St. Peter's Hospital of Brooklyn, N. Y., in consideration of treatment of such poor patients that may be sent to such institution from the Town of Riverhead?"

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
