

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, February 23, 1938 at 10:00 A.M.

Seth A. Hubbard, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 9, 1938 and a special meeting held on February 19, 1938 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Mr. C.W. Ludlum in regard to the item of \$2500. placed in the 1937 Highway budget for repairs of the sidewalk on West Main St. and Griffing Avenue. The communication was ordered placed on file and the matter referred to the Town Attorney.

Justice Warner reporting on the matter of better lighting on Marcy Ave. in the vicinity of the Polish Hall, advised the Board that the lighting was inadequate, not so much as to the number of lights but as to the size of the lights, and recommended that lamp #35 on pole #7 be changed from 80 C.P. to 600 C.P. and that lamp #40 on pole #21 be changed from 80 C.P. to 600 C.P.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to change lamp #35 on pole #7 from 80 C.P. to 600 C.P. and that lamp #40 on pole #21 be changed from 80 C.P. to 600 C.P. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Seth A. Hubbard, Town Attorney reporting on the matter in regard to the purchase of new equipment for the Highway Department advised the Board that the Supt. of Highways cannot exceed the appropriation placed in the Budget for machinery, however he advised that machinery can be purchased and paid over a period of years.

The Board then convened as a Board of audit and examined the Town bills for the month of February 1938.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday March 9, 1938 at 2:00 P.M.
