

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Saturday, September 9, 1933, pursuant to notice.

A roll call of the members of the Town Board, made by the Town Clerk was as follows:-

The following notice of the call of the Special Meeting was read by the Town Clerk:

" Please take notice of a Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, to be held on Saturday Morning, at the hour of 10 A.M. Daylight Saving Time, September 9, 1933, for the purpose of re-considering the question of placing the Town of Riverhead on a Budget System.

The following waiver of notice was read by the Town Clerk.

" Ten day notice of special meeting of Town Board of Riverhead to be held on Saturday, September 9, 1933, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon pursuant to section 143 of Town Law is hereby waived

Supervisor Homan welcomed the taxpayers present and requested that all who desired to be heard would be heard at that time.

The Board was addressed by J. Harry Saxstien, who advised that he came before the Board as an individual and also as President of the Young Men's Republican Club of Riverhead, and further advising that at an Executive Meeting of the Executive Committee of said Club, a resolution was adopted opposing the adoption of the Budget system on the grounds that it would increase taxes for the coming year.

Mr. Arno Thurm of Calverton, addressed the Board advising that he had been delegated by the Calverton Farmers Association to oppose the adoption of a Budget system because of the apparent increase in taxes for the coming year.

Mr. E. E. Smith and John R. Terrell, addressed the Board requesting certain information relative to the advantages of adopting the budget system.

Mr. John T. Hill addressed the Board and spoke in favor of the Town Board adopting the Budget system.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole, seconded by Justice Rubenstein it was Resolved That the Town Board assembled in a special meeting duly called pursuant to Section 143 of the Town Law, elect to make the provisions of Article 6A of the Town Law, applicable to the Town of Riverhead and that the finances of this Town be hereafter administered under the Budget system.

Previous to the roll call vote, several members of the Town Board expressed their views on the matter.
