

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead, held at the office of Justice Hildreth
Monday evening, June 10, 1907, at 7.30 o'clock.

Meeting was called pursuant to a notice published
in village papers that action would be taken on a petition
filed with the Town Clerk requesting the extension of the
Lighting District along east Main Street to the Brook.

An opinion was had from the town counsel stating
steps necessary to be taken in order to extend the district,
and the provisions of the law had been complied with.

On motion, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, That the Lighting District be extended
along East Main Street to the top of Brook Hill and that the
Supervisor be instructed to confer with the Lighting Company

and have as many lights placed in the extended district as may be necessary.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
