

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the office of Justice Hildreth, Monday evening, June 17, 1907, at 7.30 o'clock.

Meeting was called for purpose of going over the lighting district to ascertain where extra lights are needed in said district.

On motion, the Board took a recess and drove over the district on a tour of inspection.

Board reconvened and discussed the matter of placing additional lights through the district.

On motion, the Riverhead Lighting Company were instructed to place lights as follows:

- One at corner of Ostrander Avenue and Second Street.
- One at corner of Washington Avenue and Cemetery

Avenue.

One at corner of Griffin Avenue and Cemetery

Avenue.

One on Sweezy Avenue, midway between Cemetery Avenue and Lincoln Avenue.

Four on East Main Street from Railroad crossing to top of Brook Hill in newly extended district.

On motion, it was decided that Constable Dayton be discharged from duty as special whatchman on streets, and Nelson Hulse appointed in his place.

Also that Sheriff Wells be requested to appoint Mr. Hulse a special deputy.
