

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office,
Saturday, February 24th, 1917 at 10:00 A.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion
adopted.

On motion, the Town of Riverhead purchased from
the Studebaker Company, two pressure distributors to
be attached to the two oil wagons of the Town of Riverhead
at \$300.00 each under agreement that one be paid for
immediately and the other one to be paid for on March
1st, 1918 and that the Town Clerk and Town Superintendent
of Highways be authorized to sign such agreement.

On motion, meetings of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead from and after this date will be
held on the first and third Saturdays of each and month.

Town Superintendent of Highways, Charles O. Downs
submitted a report of different men working for him
and the compensation to be paid to each between the
dates of March 15th, 1917 and October 31st, 1917, per hour.

On motion the following raises in Highway Labor
were voted by the Town Board, as per report.

- each man and team five cents per hour extra
- each laborer three cents per hour extra

Bids for Road Oil was submitted to the Town
Board by the Standard Oil Company. This was the only
bid submitted.

On motion the bid of the Standard Oil Company of
\$.05944 (five and ninety-four one hundredths cents) per
gallon for approximately 150,000 gallons of 40% road
oil was accepted and that the Supervisor and Town Clerk
be authorized to sign Contract submitted by the Standard
Oil Company with their bid.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
