Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion of Justice, Geo. W. Hildreth the following was adopted:

WHEREAS The Riverhead Electric Light Company has been operating in the Town of Riverhead for over twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS permission to so operate was given to said Company, or its predecessors, by the Town Board and Commissioner of Highways of the Town of Riverhead some time between the years 1885 and 1887; and

WHEREAS the records of the proceedings of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead for the years 1885 and part of 1886 are practically out of existence,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Town Board and Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, hereby approve and gives to The Riverhead Electric Light Company permission to construct, maintain and operate in the streets and public places of the Town of Riverhead, poles, lines and necessary accessories for manufacture and distribution of electricity for light, heat and power.
