

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held in office of Justice Hildreth, Monday evening, Oct. 14, 1907.

Meeting called for purpose of defining the new lighting district as extended along East Main Street.

The following were on motion fixed as the boundaries of said district:

Commencing at Peconic River at or near the Southeast corner of land of Alonzo P. Terry, thence running Northerly by and with the East Line of land of Alonzo P. Terry and by and with the southerly line of land of Usher B. Howell and Frank G. Howell to the west line of the New Boulevard, thence Northerly by and with the west line of said New Boulevard to the Long Island R. R., thence Easterly along said Railroad to Saw Mill Brook, thence Northerly along said Saw Mill Brook to the north line of School District No. 5, thence westerly along the North line of School Dist. No. 5 to the east line of land of James H. Corwin, thence southerly along the east line of land of said James H. Corwin to the Long Island Railroad.

There being no Town Sealer of Weights and Measures in the town of Riverhead, as requested by law, Lorimer M. Raynor was duly appointed to such office.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
