On motion a committee of four was appointed by the Supervisor to raise necessary funds to have a public flag raising in the Village of Riverhead.

The following committee was appointed: Geo. W. Hildreth, Chairman, B. Frank Howell, Jr., Stanley C. Duvall, Edw. W. Carter.

On motion with the consent of the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead, permission is given to place a flag pole at intersection of Peconic Avenue and Main Street in the Village of Riverhead, N.Y.

On motion O. Edmund Griswold was appointed Water Commissioner for term of one year from April 16th, 1917 and H. Harrison Corwin was appointed Water Commissioner for a term of two years from April 16th, 1917, and Wm. D. Duvall was appointed Water Commissioner for a term of three years from April 16th, 1917.
