

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Monday, June 4, 1928 at 7:30 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, of May 31, 1928 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

Mr. Cecil B. Tooker presented and read his opinion in regard to the Petition for a Police District, which opinion advised that the signatures of persons signing for Corporations were not valid, in his opinion, unless the corporation seal was also attached.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the matter of the Petition for a Proposed Police District be referred to Cecil B. Tooker, to ascertain if there is any way possible that this Petition may be made valid.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the Petition for a Police District be referred to the Board of Assessors to ascertain if the signatures attached represent more than fifty per centum of the assessed valuation of the Proposed Police District.

Thomas Danowski and K. Tenkowski, representing the Polish Citizens Independent Club addressed the Board and asked if there was any reason why Anthony F. Przyborowski should not be re-appointed a Special Constable.

A Bond of the National Surety Company, bonding Dennis G. Homan as Supervisor, in the amount of \$94,000.00 was presented and on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Bond of the National Surety Company, in the amount of \$94,000.00 bonding Dennis G. Homan, as Supervisor be and the same is hereby approved.

Justice Conklin brought the matter of appointing a dog catcher for the Town of Riverhead before the Board and Supervisor Homan appointed Justice Conklin and Town Clerk Burns, a committee to look into the matter and report back to the Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that Supervisor Homan and Town Clerk Burns be and they hereby are authorized to purchase a street marking machine for the Town of Riverhead.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the chair.
