

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office Saturday, May 5th, 1917 at 10:00 A.M.

Minutes of previous meeting, ^{read} and on motion adopted.

On motion, the following polling places were designated as registration centers:

Election District #1	Wading River Hall.
" " #2	Lyceum.
" " #3	Town Hall
" " #4	Casino
" " #5	Harmony Hall

On motion the Inspectors of Election, Poll Clerks and Ballot Clerks of each election district, who served at last election take charge of the work of registration.

In compliance with the request of Mr. Amza W. Biggs, Chairman of registration Board, it is the desire of the Town Board to accomplish the entire registration within the Town of Riverhead without expense either for service of committees, registrars, clerks or for the hire of Polling Places.

On motion, the Supervisor was authorized to transfer \$300.00 from the Snow Fund to the Machinery Fund.

On motion the resignation of Mr. W. W. Conklin as Inspector of Election for the 5th Election District of the Town of Riverhead was accepted and Mr. Fred B. Hallock of Jamesport was appointed in his place by written request of Mr. Henry L. Tyler, County Committeeman from the 5th district.

On motion the Town Clerk and Town Superintendent of Highways were appointed a committee to investigate matter of accepting Ostrander Avenue Extension as a Highway and report back to Town Board.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
