

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office on June 27, 1928 at 7:30 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Board, held June 18, 1928 were approved.

A communication received from the Horni Signal Manufacturing Company, advising that their representative would be in Riverhead this week to regulate the traffic signal, was read.

A communication received from Z. R. Hallock, requesting permission to run a railroad track siding across Railroad Avenue, Jamesport, N.Y. about 30 feet west of his present crossing was read.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the request of Z. R. Hallock for permission to run a railroad track siding over Railroad Avenue at Jamesport, N. Y., about 30 feet west of the present crossing be and the same hereby is granted.

Luther E. Johnson of Manorville, N.Y., addressed the Board and advised that the sand from the highway was constantly filling up the ditch on his cranberry marsh and on motion and vote this matter was referred to the Superintendent of Highways.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to have an awning placed in front of the Town Office.

The committee looking into the matter of appointing a Dog Catcher for the Town of Riverhead, advised that it had been in communication with a representative from the Department of Farms and Markets, who had recommended a dog catcher to the committee and that the committee was waiting to hear from him.

The Town Clerk was instructed to write the Town Clerk.

of Southampton and see if the Town of Southampton was interested in appointing a dog catcher, it being the opinion that the matter of catching dogs could be more satisfactory taken care of if there was one dog catcher for the two towns.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificates of indebtedness the sum of FORTY FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 Dollars, (\$4500.00) to pay on account of audited bills of June 26, 1928.

Ellis S. Duvall and Hubert F. Corwin, Water Commissioners, were present and advised the Board that the Contractor who is to lay the water mains in Riverhead, had given the Water Commissioners a certified check in the amount of \$500.00 which is to guarantee that the highways will be left in good condition after the water mains have been laid.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm or corporation, to disturb, tear up or otherwise interfere with any of the highways in the Town of Riverhead, except by and with the consent and authority of the Town Superintendent of Highways of said town and under his supervision, authority and control; and be it further

RESOLVED That all the expense incident to the repairing and placing in proper condition of said highways after tearing up disturbing or otherwise interfering with such highways as herein provided shall be borne by the person or persons, firm or corporation requesting such change or disturbance; and be it further

RESOLVED That before any street or highway may be dug into opened or interfered with for the purpose of making any connection or for any other purpose whatever a written permit must first be obtained from the Town Superintendent of Highways, and a certified check for at least \$10.00 deposited, which will be a guarantee of replacing the road in a condition satisfactory to the Superintendent and be it further

RESOLVED That certified checks deposited with the Superintendent of Highways shall be turned over to the Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead, who will return them to the persons or persons, firm or corporation upon the written release of the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the L. I. Lighting Company be instructed to install a bracket type of street light on the corner of Main

Street and Osborn Avenue and a bracket type of street light on the corner of Court Street and Main Street, in the Village of Riverhead.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the Town purchase eighteen of the street parking signs and posts at a price of \$6.75 each complete, f.o.b. cars, from C. F. McCullough of Larchmont, N.Y.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the Chair.
