RESOLUTIONS
#169 AUTHORIZES TOWN CLERK TO PUBLISH AND POST NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING, RE: RENEWAL OF FRANCHISE OR CERTIFICATE OF CONFIRMATION BY LONG ISLAND CABLEVISION.

Councilman Artale offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to publish and post the below Public Notice with regard to the application for renewal of franchise or certificate of confirmation by Long Island Cablevision.

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held on the 19th day of April, 1983, at 8:15 o'clock p.m. at the Riverhead Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York to hear all interested persons with regard to the application for renewal of franchise or certificate of confirmation by Long Island Cablevision for a franchise pursuant to section 64(7) of the Town Law to renew and extend a cable TV franchise in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York. The application and proposal for modernization of Long Island Cablevision Corporation service in the Town of Riverhead are on file with the Town Clerk having offices at 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, which documents are available for inspection during regular business hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Applicant, Long Island Cablevision, seeks a renewal and extension of its current franchise for a period not to exceed 11 years from the date of determination of the application by the Town of Riverhead. Applicant represents in its proposals, as more fully stated therein, that it will provide reconstruction of approximately 130 miles of cable television plant now existing in the Town of Riverhead with additional construction of new facilities in the following areas:

1. Peconic Bay Blvd. from Beach Road, Jamesport, east to Laurel Lane, Laurel, to include roads running south of Peconic Bay Blvd, i.e. Smith Lane, Kirby Lane, Williamson Lane, Beach Road, Cedar Court.
2. Sound Avenue from Osborne Avenue East to Dolphin Way and serve roads off Sound Avenue to include Reeves Park, Roanoke Avenue north and south to include Rolling Woods, Dolphin Way.
3. West Lane In Aquebogue from Route 25 north to Pole #25.
4. Doctors Path from Lilco north to Pole #23 and serve Booker Drive.

Applicant represents that the new plant to be provided shall furnish capacity of 36 television channels to all subscribers to be available within six months from the date that the proposed franchise renewal is executed.

Applicant requests a rate increase from its current monthly service rate, residential, first outlet, of \$8.15 to \$13.00 per month, residential, first outlet, as shown above, including optional listing of not less than 25 channels. This 25 channel service will include an electronic channel selector that would enable subscribers to view the 25 channel on their present television sets.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is authorized to publish this notice in the March 31st and April 7th issues of The New Review, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk shall file proof of publication with the Commission on Cable Television of the State of New York within the (10) days of last publication, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the application shall not be acted upon prior to the 30th day following the second publication of this notice.

#170 APPOINTS JOHN CHRABOLOWSKI AS SENIOR BUILDING INSPECTOR

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to employ a highly qualified Building Inspector to perform the duties previously performed by Raymond Wiwczar,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that John Chrabolowski, be appointed provisionally to the position of Senior Building Inspector at an annual salary of \$19,331, effective March 28, 1983 to oversee building and fire inspections within the Town of Riverhead.


RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Raymond Wiwczar.
