

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Thursday, December 28, 1933 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the Town Board meeting held on December 20, 1933 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

The Town Clerk advised that the bonds of Robert Burnside, Justice of the Peace, George E. Luce, Justice of the Peace, Harry J. Kratoville, Town Clerk, William H. Clark, Superintendent of Highways and Milton L. Burns, as Supervisor had been filed with the County Clerk according to law and that a receipt for same had been received and placed on file.

On motion duly made by Justice Stackpole, seconded by Justice Frederick and duly carried it was Resolved That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificate of indebtedness the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars to pay on account of Audited Bills of December 30, 1933 and outstanding bills for the year 1933.

Supervisor Homan addressed the Board, expressing his deep appreciation to the members of the Board for the co-operation which he had received from them during his terms of office as Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead and wishing the members of the new Town Board every success for their terms of office.

On motion duly made by Justice Burnside, seconded by Justice Stackpole and unanimously carried it was Resolved That this Board express to Supervisor Homan, its deep appreciation for the able manner in which he had conducted the Town Board Meetings and the affairs of this Town and be it further Resolved That this Board express to Supervisor Homan its thanks for his expression of best wishes.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
