Bid of Riverhead Electric Light Co., reading as follows, was adopted:

"We will furnish seventy-eight (78) incandescent lights of 25 candle power each and light the Riverhead Village, lighting district every night one half hour after sun down until one o'clock A. M., for one thousand Dollars (\$1000.) per year, for the term of three years from date.

February 19, 1906.

Riverhead Electric Light Co."

On motion, the bid for the Riverhead Electric Light Co. was accepted, providing said company will furnish extra lights pro rata at any time or at any place in the lighting district as at present, or as may be hereafter extended.
