

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office, Tuesday, Nov. 30, 1906, at 7.30 o'clock, P. M.

Meeting called for purpose of fixing amounts to be inserted in the tax budget for coming year.

The following resolutions were adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy for the year 1906 the sum of \$7500. for highway purposes.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$577. expense of laying out Cemetery Avenue extension.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$875. expense of laying out Harrison Avenue.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$638. expense of

Forge Road alteration.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$2,015.50, expense of laying out Riverside Drive.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$200. to be used for the purchase of a new road machine in Wading River district.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$1000. for Highway Commissioner's services and removal of snow.

Resolved, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$4,304.52 for Audited Bills.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$1000. for lighting the village lighting district.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy the sum of \$1500. for Fire Department purposes.

A petition was presented by the Highway Commissioner to open a new highway at Wading River, commencing on the Manor Road about a quarter of a mile southerly from the L. I. R. R. depot and running southeasterly to lands of John C. Grennell and R. J. Graves.

The Highway Commissioner did not deem the road  
advisable and on motion the counsel for the town were in-  
structed to oppose the application.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
