

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office, Wednesday
April 19, 1905, at three o'clock.

Present:

A communication was received from Highway Commis-
sioner Howard V. Lane calling the attention of the Town
Board to the unsafe condition of the bridge on Peconic
Avenue between the Town of Riverhead and the Town of
Southampton, and recommending that a new bridge be built.

On motion, the Town Clerk was instructed to arrange
for a joint meeting between the Town Boards of the Town of
Riverhead and the Town of Southampton to take action in the
matter.

The following resolution was offered by Justice
Hildreth, and adopted:

WHEREAS there has been a demand by some of the

residents of the Town of Southampton and Riverhead that a line be established in Peconic River near the head of Merritts' Bay, below which nets and lines may lawfully be set for fish, now be it

Resolved that this Board recommend to the Board of Supervisors of Suffolk County, that they establish a line in said Peconic River, at or near the west end of Merritt's Bay, below which it shall be lawful to set nets and lines for fish.

On motion, Carl Locker was appointed to the office of Game Constable in and for the town of Riverhead, to fill the vacancy called by the failure of Geo. H. L'Hommedieu, Game Constable elect, to qualify.

There being no further business, Board proceeded to organize as a Board of Health, for the ensuing year.
