

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 3, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on Wednesday, August 20, 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Dr. J.L. Cantor in regard to a four car parking area on the west side of Roanoke Ave. in front of his residence. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Gordon Y. Billard of 322 Roanoke in regard to ~~the double~~ parking on Third Street at the intersection of Roanoke Ave. and requested the Board to take some action on the matter. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mrs Ruth T. Hill offering her property on the west side of Roanoke Avenue to the Town of Riverhead for a parking field for the rental price of \$30.00 per month, however, in the event that other owners involved receive larger amounts, she would expect a proportionate increase for her property. *The communication was ordered placed on file.*

A communication was read from Harry G. Penny, Sec.-Treas. of the Riverhead Fire Dept. dated August 26, 1947, giving notice of an injury to Wesley Slavonik while on duty. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Police report for the month of August 1947 was read and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion Made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Adam Harkness be and he hereby is appointed School Traffic Officer for the Jamesport School under the direction and supervision of the Chief of Police of the Town of Riverhead. Justices Leonard and Zaleski absent, Justices Warner and Yousik Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 3, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town and Highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 17, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.
