

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of the town of Riverhead, N. Y., held in the Town Clerk's office, Wednesday, June 7, 1905, at three o'clock P. M.

A petition was received, signed by twenty-five taxpayers, requesting the Town Board to extend the present lighting district to the brook in the east end of the village.

On motion, the Supervisor was instructed to confer with the Riverhead Electric Light Co. and ascertain at what price they will place four additional lights and maintain the same.

The following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be and is hereby authorized to pay any claims against the town, provided the same are approved by a majority of the Town Board.

On motion, Board adjourned until Tuesday, June 13, at three o'clock.
