Minutes of previous meeting read and motion adopted.

On motion the Committee appointed to confer with
the Electric Light Company made their full report and
they were discharged from further duties in the matter.

On motion, Supervisor B. Frank Howell, Jr., Justice
of the Peace, Wm. F. Flanagan and Superintendent of
Highways, Charles O. Downs were appointed a Committee to
install ten new lights to supply adequate light to the
business section of the Village of Riverhead, and remove
those of the smaller lights, which they see fit to remove,
and to place the larger lights in such places over the
Streets or Avenues where in their opinion they would be
of the most benefit, and that each light shall not cost
over \$75.00 per year, and such contract for the new lights
be for one year from the date of installation.

On motion, the resignation of Henry A. Hallock,
Inspector of Election, 5th district of the Town of Riverhead
was accepted.

On motion Chester Tuthill was appointed Inspector
of Election in and for the 5th district, Town of Riverhead
in place of Henry A. Hallock resigned.

On motion Supervisor B. Frank Howell, Jr. and Town
Clerk Jos. W. Kratoville were authorized to borrow the
sum of \$674.00 to pay audited bills.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
