

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead, N.Y., held in the Town Clerk's office,
Monday, June 26, 1905, at three o'clock, P.M.

Present:

On motion, adjournment was taken to the Town Hall.

The meeting was a joint one between the Town Board
and Highway Commissioner for the purpose of entering into
an agreement between said parties as to the expenditure of
the highway money, pursuant to Sec. 53 of the Highway Law.

The following resolutions were adopted:

RESOLVED, That on the road leading from the
Baiting Hollow church to the Southold Town Line, a distance
of seven miles, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) be
expended.

RESOLVED, That on the road leading from the
Main Road to the Peconic Bay, a distance of One mile, the

sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) be expended.

RESOLVED, That on the road leading from East Street to the Brook in the village of Riverhead, a distance of one mile, the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty (\$350.) Dollars be expended.

RESOLVED, That on the road leading from the Barker Robinson place to the Bermann farm, a distance of one mile, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) be expended.

RESOLVED, That the sum of \$2479.97 be reserved to be expended as we may hereafter agree and determine.

On motion, the Highway Commissioner was authorized to change the road passing the Barker Robinson place from the north side of the pond to the south side, as now traveled.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
