

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of  
Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Tuesday, May 15, 1934 at 9:30 A. M.

On motion duly made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by  
Justice Luce, it was RESOLVED, by unanimous consent, that the reading of  
the minutes of the previous meetings held May 1 and May 8, 1934 be dis-  
penssed until the next regular meeting of the Town Board.

The Town Board then convened as Board of Audit and ex-  
amined the Town Welfare bills for the month of April.

A bill from Van Rensselaer Skidmore Post No. 2476, River-  
head, N. Y., Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U. S. for rent and mainten-  
ance of Post Rooms was submitted to the Board for Audit.

On motion duly made by Justice Rubenstein and seconded by  
Justice Luce, it was RESOLVED, by unanimous consent that the above bill was  
not audited, due to the fact that the bill was not made out in the proper  
form and that the Town Clerk be directed to notify Frank A. Balser,  
Commander of the Post to that effect.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the  
Board adjourned till May 29, 1934 at 10:00 A. M.
