A communication was read from Mr. George W. Hildreth, Attorney at Law protesting against the establishment of labor camps in the Town of Riverhead. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A petition signed by approximately 236 residents of the vicinity of Calverton protesting against the establishment of a labor camp in Calverton was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

Mr. Marshall Rogers, Mr. John Doroski, Mrs George Hackal, Mr. Treadwell Cheshire, Mr. Myron Cheshire, Mr. Henry Danowski, Mr. Joseph Jackiewicz, Mr. Andrew Nabor, Mr. S. De Lorenzo, Mr. Charles Smith and Mr. George Hackal addressed the Board protesting against the establishment of a labor camp in the vicinity of Calverton and were opposed to labor camps in any part of the town.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead hold a public hearing in the Town Hall at Riverhead, New York on Wednesday, November 19, 1947, on the question of labor camps in the Town of Riverhead and that the Town Clerk be authorized to publish notice thereof. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

There being no further notice on motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
