

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board as a Board of Audit, held in Town Hall, Friday, Mar. 27, 1908, at 1 o'clock, P. M.

On motion, Justices were appointed a committee on Constables' and Deputy Sheriff's bills, and the whole Board acted on other bills.

Bills amounting to \$2631.25, and Board of Health Bills amounting to \$122.60, were examined, and audited.

Overseer of Poor Terry submitted his semi-annual report, which was examined and approved.

On motion, Justice Hildreth offered the following resolution, which, on motion, was adopted:

Resolved, that the Commissioner of Highways of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to notify the residents of Riverhead Town, particularly those residing and having places of business on Main Street, in the Village of

Riverhead in said Town, informing them of the penalties of throwing paper and rubbish in the highways, or allowing said paper or rubbish to blow or be carried from said premises on said Highways.
