Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion made seconded and carried, Town Clerk, Joseph  
W. Kratoville was authorized to have published two times in  
each of the local papers the following ordinance and have  
necessary number cardboard copies of same printed.

**FIRE CRACKER ORDINANCE**

Notice is hereby given that at a meeting of  
the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead,  
County of Suffolk and State of New York,  
held on June 18, 1920, the following ordinance  
was presented and adopted according to law:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to set  
off at any time any fire crackers whatever on  
the public highways in the Town of Riverhead,  
and it shall also be unlawful for any person  
or persons to build bonfires or to set off any  
fireworks on the public highways in the said  
Town of Riverhead at any time. Any person  
violating any of the provisions of this ordi-  
nance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and  
punishable in a case of conviction by a fine not  
exceeding \$50 or imprisonment in the county  
jail for a term not exceeding six months or by  
both such fine and imprisonment."

The authority to pass this ordinance is found  
in Art. 2 of the Public Health Laws of the  
State of New York.

On motion made, seconded and carried Supervisor, B. Frank Howell was authorized to have appointed such Deputy Sheriffs as he might deem necessary to act on July 3rd, 4th and 5th, 1920.

On motion, made, seconded and carried Supervisor B. Frank Howell was authorized to have appointed a Special Deputy Sheriff for season of 1920 to regulate traffic on Main Street in the Village of Riverhead such days and nights as the Supervisor might deem necessary.

Town Superintendent of Highways, Howard V. Lane submitted the following increase in pay for Teams, Foremen, Laborers and Man and one horse on the Roads of the Town of Riverhead and recommended that the new schedule of pay commence on June 16th, 1920.

On motion made, seconded and carried Howard V. Lane, Superintendent of Highways was authorized to increase the pay of Teams, Foremen and Laborers as above from June 16th, 1920.

On motion made seconded and carried the per diem compensation of the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead was raised from \$5.00 per day to \$7.00 per day.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
