Minutes of previous meeting read and motion adopted.

It was brought to the attention of the Town Board that the temporary Town Hospital for Infantile Paralysis was occupied by the Town of Riverhead, and on motion the matter was referred to Health Officer, *Dr.* Allan G. Terrell with instructions to report back to the Town Board.

On motion made, seconded and carried J. Fred Dugan was appointed to fill the duties of Town Clerk in the absence of Joseph W. Kratoville, Town Clerk, who is in the service of the United States Army.

A bill for services of Frank H. Hill & Bros. for burial of body of Madaline Marran was presented to the Town Board and on motion, Town Clerk was appointed a committee with instructions to find in what Town Madaline Marran actually claimed residence, and report back to Town Board.

On motion, Supervisor, B. Frank Howell, Jr. was authorized to have five deputy Sheriffs appointed to act during the Fair, each Special deputy Sheriff to receive a compensation of \$3.00 per day.

On motion the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead authorized Town Superintendent of Highways, Charles O. Downs to ~~lease~~ lease to Mr. James E. Gay the Concrete Mixer owned by the Town of Riverhead at the rate of \$3.00 per day when in use, upon the condition that the lessee will guarantee the safe return of the Concrete Mixer.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
