Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion, seconded and carried, B. Frank Howell was
authorized to have necessary number of Special Deputy
Sheriffs appointed to act during the Fair, each Special
Deputy Sheriff to receive such compensation as the Supervisor
B. Frank Howell decides upon.

On motion seconded and carried it was ordered that all
Hacks, Motor Buses or Jitneys operating in Riverhead during
period from Sept. 16th, 1919 to Sept. 20th, 1919 inclusive
be required to pay license fees of \$10.00 for each Bus with
a capacity of ten or more passengers and \$5.00 for each
Bus with a capacity of less than 10 passengers. Any
violation to this ordinance is punishable by a fine not to
exceed \$50.00.

Communication from the University of the State of

New York, State Department of Education relative to the
appointment of a Historian in and for the Town of
Riverhead was read and filed.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
