

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 2, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 28, 1951 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Edward W. Connors be and he hereby is appointed Town Attorney for the Town of Riverhead, salary fixed at the rate of \$2300.00 per annum. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Attorney Connors was sworn in by Justice Gatz and was thereupon declared duly qualified as Town Attorney.

The Town Clerk advised that he has filed all Officers Bonds and Oaths of Office with the County Clerk pursuant to Law.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that Harry J. Kratoville be and he hereby is appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics for the Town of Riverhead for the term ending on December 31, 1953. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes, The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Suffolk County Trust Company, Suffolk County National Bank and the Long Island State Bank and Trust Company be and they hereby are designated as depositories in which the Supervisor, Town Clerk and Receiver of Taxes of this Town shall deposit all moneys coming into their hands by virtue of their offices. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the News-Review of Riverhead, New York be designated the official newspaper of the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the Association of Towns of the State of New York advising that its Annual Convention will be held in the City of Buffalo, N.Y. on February 6-7-8, 1952 and urged all officers to attend. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor, Justices of the Peace, Town Attorney, Supt. of Highways, Town Clerk, Assessors, Clerk to the Assessors, Members of the Town Planning Board and the Consultant to the Town Planning Board be authorized to attend the Annual Convention of the Associations of the

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State of New York to be held in the City of Buffalo on February 6-7-8, 1952 and that all necessary expenses be paid. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that Joseph V. Kelly, Supervisor be designated the official Delegate to Annual Meeting of the New York State Association of Towns and that Justice Austin H. Warner be designated alternate Delegate. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The ~~Yobels~~ Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, ^{Supervisor Kelly yes,} the resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Current Surplus Account to the Riverhead Town Civilian Defense Account. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the Veterans of Foreign Wars asking permission to hold a Carnival on the Fair Grounds during the week of June 30th, 1952. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the request of the Veterans of Foreign Wars to hold a carnival on the Fair Grounds during the week of June 30, 1952 be granted, subject to the rules and regulations governing the use of Town controlled property for bazaars, carnivals and circuses. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

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The Police report for the month of December 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of Taxes collected as of January 2, 1952 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the total of which was \$13,669.56 follows: General Town Fund-
