

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 16, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on January 2, 1952 ^{was read} and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A report of the Town of Riverhead Planning Board for the year 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the New York State Public Service Commission relative to the petition of the Long Island Lighting Co. for authority to increase the thermal content of gas to 1,000 b.t.u. per cubic foot and to spread the cost of converting consumers' appliances and charging for abandoned property over a period of years, advising the Board that the testimony introduced and exhibits marked for identification at the initial hearing may be examined at the New York office of the Commission, 233 Broadway, New York, N.Y. on any business day. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication from the Ladies' Auxiliary, V.F.W. requesting permission to hold a carnival on the Fairgrounds from July 21 to 26, 1952. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the request of the Ladies' Auxiliary, V.F.W. for permission to hold a carnival on the Fairgrounds from July 21 to 26, 1952 be granted, subject to the rules and regulations governing the use of Town owned and controlled property for carnivals, circuses and bazaars. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Supervisor's report for the month of December, 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Annual Police report for the year 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of January 16, 1952 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.
