

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board as a Board of Audit, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Tuesday, November 21, 1905, at 9 o'clock A. M.

On motion, Justices of the Peace were appointed a Committee on Constables' and Sheriff's Bills, and the full Board acted on all other bills, except that members had no voice in the auditing of their own bills.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was presented examined and approved.

On motion, the sum of \$1100. was appropriated to the Overseer of the Poor out of the Contingent Fund.

On motion, the Overseer of the Poor was instructed to pay no more money or aid otherwise to Martha Dayton, on the ground that she has been living out of the town for the past three years.
