

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 19, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 5, 1952 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from The Long Island Rail Road Company acknowledging receipt of a certified copy of a resolution adopted by the Town Board on March 5, 1952 in regard to the dangerous rail road crossings in the Town of Riverhead. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from the New York State Public Service Commission acknowledging receipt of a certified copy of a resolution adopted by the Town Board on March 5, 1952 in regard to the dangerous rail road crossings in the Town of Riverhead ~~###~~ requesting a public hearing on the matter before the Commission. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. George W. Hildreth together with a resolution from the Riverhead Yacht Club petitioning the Town Board to erect docking facilities similar to the ones now in existence, and including the entire water frontage along the Peconic River Parking field. The communication and resolution were ordered placed on file.

It was the consensus of opinion of the members of the Town that due to the fact that the Town does not own the property of the Peconic River Parking field, additional dockage does not seem feasible at this time.

The Supervisor's report for the month of February, 1952 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of March 17, 1952 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Bids for the pruning of approximately 156 trees in the Town of Riverhead were opened as follows;

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved, that the bid of The Davey Tree Expert Co. to prune approximately 156 trees in the Town of Riverhead for the sum of \$889.20 be and the same is hereby accepted and that the Supervisor be authorized to enter into an agreement with the said Company for the said amount. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was read from The Long Island Association asking the Board to publicize the Town of Riverhead in their 16th Edition of Long Island.. The Sunrise Homeland as in the past. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Gatz and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead take one page of advertisement in the 16th Edition of "Long Island...The Sunrise Homeland" published by The Long Island Association for the sum not to exceed \$230.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead purchase a strip of land from Mrs May A. Hoffman for the sum of \$50.00 for the purpose of widening the North Wading River Road. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date the totals of which were as follows: General Town Fund-\$3342.95, Highway Machinery Fund-\$1574.21.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 2, 1952 at 2:00 P.M.
