

Minutes of a Joint Meeting of the Town Board and Highway Commissioner, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Thursday, November 23, 1905, at 7.00 o'clock, P.M.

Meeting called for purpose of fixing the amounts to be used for highway purposes for the coming year.

The following resolutions were offered and adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized and instructed to insert in the tax levy the sum of \$6500. for highway purposes for the year 1906.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized and instructed to insert in the tax levy for 1906 the sum of \$1150. for damages and expense of opening road from Middle Road to Osborne Ave.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized and instructed to insert in the tax levy for 1906 the sum of

\$850.00 for damages and expense of opening road from depot at Wading River to the Baiting Hollow Road.

RESOLVED, that the Highway Commissioner be authorized and instructed to purchase for the sum of \$100.00 if possible land for a new road west from Cemetery Ave. to Raynor Ave. in the Village and Town of Riverhead, and if said land can be purchased for aboveamount, that he be authorized and is hereby instructed to pay out and open said road.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized and instructed to have inserted in the tax levy for 1906 the sum of \$1000.00 for pay of highway commissioner's services and removal of snow.

RESOLVED, that there be inserted in the tax levy the audited bills of spring and fall audit.

On motion the Supervisor was authorized to borrow upon the credit of the town the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000.)

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
