The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, that the Town Board reccommend that a County Engineer be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

An application was made for an electric light to be placed on Ostrander avenue and on motion the Supervisor was instructed to have a street light placed there.

A resolution was adopted calling the attention of the
Commissioner of Highways to the condition of the roads in
the Calverton district.
