

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on January 2, 1964 at 10:30 A. M.

Councilman Grodski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Zaloga.

RESOLVED, That Shepard M. Scheinberg be and he is hereby appointed Town Attorney to serve until the first day of January next succeeding the first biennial town election held after his appointment (i.e. January 1966) at an annual salary of \$4,000, payable monthly, effective January 1, 1964.

WHEREAS, The Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, has heretofore duly authorized, sold and issued its \$38,500 Bond Anticipation Note for Herod Point Road Improvements-1963 pursuant to the Resolution duly adopted by the Town Board on January 15, 1963, and it is now necessary to redeem said Note to the extent of \$2,500 from a source other than the proceeds of the bonds in anticipation of which said Note has been issued, now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. The \$38,500 Bond Anticipation Note for Herod Point Road Improvements-1963 of the Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, is hereby authorized to be redeemed on or before January 15, 1964, to the extent of \$2,500 from funds of said Town now available to said purpose, said funds being a source other than the proceeds of the bonds in anticipation of which said Note was issued and the said amount of \$2,500 is hereby appropriated therefor.

BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JANUARY 2, 1964, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL, IN PART, OF A \$38,500 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE FOR HEROD POINT ROAD IMPROVEMENTS-1963, BY THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW NOTE IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$36,000.

Recital

WHEREAS, The Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, has heretofore duly authorized, sold and issued its \$38,500 Bond Anticipation Note for Herod Point Road Improvements-1963 and has authorized the redemption of said Note to the extent of \$2,500, and it is now necessary and desirable to provide for the renewal, in part, of said Note by the issuance of a new Note in the principal amount of \$36,000; now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. The \$38,500 Bond Anticipation Note for Herod Point Road Improvements-1963 of the Town of Riverhead, in the County of Suffolk, New York, dated January 15, 1963, maturing January 15, 1964, Numbered R-3, heretofore duly authorized, sold and issued pursuant to the Resolution duly adopted by the Town Board on January 15, 1963, is hereby authorized to be renewed, in part, by the issuance of a new Note in the principal amount of \$36,000, said Note dated January 15, 1963 having been heretofore authorized to be redeemed from a source other than the proceeds of the bonds in anticipation of which it was issued, to the extent of \$2,500, all as hereinabove referred to in the Recital hereof, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York. The maturity of said renewal Note herein authorized shall not be later than one year from its date, and said Note may be further renewed pursuant to the provisions of said Local Finance Law.

Section 2. The terms, form and details of said renewal Note shall be as follows:-

Section 3. Said Note is hereby sold to SECURITY NATIONAL BANK OF LONG ISLAND, Riverhead Branch, Riverhead, New York, at the price of par, to bear interest at the rate of one and one-half per centum (1-1/2%) per annum, payable at maturity, and the Supervisor is hereby authorized to deliver said Note to said purchaser upon receipt of the principal amount, plus accrued interest, if any, from the date of said Note to the date of delivery.

Section 4. Said Note shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by Sec. 52.00 of said Local Finance Law, and shall be a general obligation of the Town, payable as to both principal and interest by a general tax upon all the taxable real property within the Town, without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the Town are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said Note and provision shall be made in the budget of the Town by appropriation for the redemption of the Note to mature in such year and for the payment of interest to be due in such year.

Section 5. Said Note shall be executed in the name of the Town by its Supervisor and the corporate seal of said Town shall be affixed thereto and attested by its Town Clerk.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

A resolution submitted by the Town of Riverhead Planning Board, recommending to the Town Board, the creation of the Open Development Area, "In the Matter of the Application of Alexander E. Horton for a designation of certain real property as an Open Development Area, pursuant to Section 280-a of the Town Law, was read and ordered placed on file.

Justice Costello offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:-

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Riverhead referred to the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead on November 13, 1962, the application of ALEXANDER E. HORTON for an Open Development Area adjacent to rights of way known as South Road, Gladys Drive and Rita Court located in the Hamlet of Wading River, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, and

WHEREAS, The Planning Board did thereafter investigate the application aforesaid and did determine that the rights of way at the site of the Open Development Area had been duly established prior to June 15, 1959 and that the roads were thereafter surfaced and approved in accordance with the regulations of the Town of Riverhead pertaining to Open Development Areas, and

WHEREAS, The Planning Board did by resolution set a date for public hearing and did advertise in the NEWS REVIEW on September 12, 1963 calling for a public hearing on December 18, 1963, and

WHEREAS, On that date a public hearing was held, and

WHEREAS, On that date the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead did duly resolve and recommend to the Town Board that the aforesaid Town Board create the Open Development Area as shown on a plan entitled "Map of Streets at Wading River, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York" prepared by William G. Meier, Licensed Land Surveyor and dated November 12, 1963, and that the Open Development Area aforesaid be sub-

ject to all the conditions and limitations contained in the "General Rule of the Town of Riverhead Planning Board Prescribing Conditions and Limitations to be applied to Open Development Areas", and therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead does and it hereby creates and determines that the application of ALEXANDER E. HORTON for an Open Development Area adjacent to rights of way known as South Road, Gladys Drive and Rita Court located in the Hamlet of Wading River, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York as detailed upon a certain plan entitled "Map of Streets at Wading River, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, aforesaid, be and it hereby is granted. Subject, however, to all of the conditions and limitations contained in the "General Rule of the Town of Riverhead Planning Board Prescribing Conditions and Limitations to be applied to Open Development Areas."

The adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Justice Zaloga and duly put to a vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:-

RESOLVED, That the Town Superintendent of Highways be authorized to purchase equipment, tools and implements without prior approval of the Town Board in an amount not exceeding \$500.00.

The vote, Councilman Young, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A communication was submitted by the Town of Riverhead Planning Board requesting permission of the Town Board to study and report on changes, revisions or additions on: (1) Camps, (2) Camp Ordinance, (3) Excavations (4) Building area allowed for multiple residence. Communication ordered placed on file.

Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the Town of Riverhead Planning Board be and is hereby granted permission to make a study and report on possible changes, revisions or additions on the following items:

1. Camps allowed in Industrial Use Districts and in Farm Use Districts when approved as a Special Exception.
2. Camp Ordinance.
3. Excavations are allowed in the Town without any restrictions.
4. Building area allowed for multiple residences in the various zoning use districts.

AND FURTHER RESOLVED, That Ordinance No. 9, pertaining to "Licensing of Junk Dealers and Dealers in Second Hand Articles", be reviewed and included in the study and report.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

A Petition, "In the Matter of the Application of RENE GENDRON to amend or change the zoning ordinance of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York", was presented to the Board.

Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Zaloga.

RESOLVED, That the petition, "In the Matter of the Application of Rene Gendron to amend or change the zoning ordinance of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York", be referred to the Planning Board for its study, and upon completion of its study, to report its findings to the Town Board.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the next meeting of the Town Board shall be held on January 14, 1964 at 10:30 A. M.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Grodski.

RESOLVED, That the Official Meetings of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, beginning with the month of February, 1964, shall be held on the first and third Tuesday of each month, at 10:30 A. M.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Supervisor Vojvoda assigned Councilmen Grodski and Young as a Committee to make a study of the Employees' Grievance Procedure and report to the Town Board.

Town Attorney Scheinberg advised the Board that he has examined the \$26,000 Bond securing the performance by Roanoke Homes, Inc., of its obligations under contract with the Town of Riverhead, and found that the Bond is in default.

The Town Clerk was directed to notify Mr. Eugene Romano of Roanoke Homes, Inc., of the findings of the Town Attorney in the matter of \$26,000 Bond, and request that he come before the Board and state his intentions.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for Liquid Asphalt requirements for the year of 1964, for the Town of Riverhead Highway Department. The Specifications to be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Justice Zaloga offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Costello.

RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids for the Transit-Mix Concrete requirements for the year of 1964, for the Town of Riverhead Highway Department. The Specifications to be prepared by the Superintendent of Highways.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Police Chief Grodski reported on the Police Department Facility. He stated that vast alterations to the stairway are needed and added that a detailed report on the Police Facility would be submitted to the Board on January 14, 1964.

Police Chief Grodski also suggested that the Meter Ordinance No. 13 be studied for changes, revisions or additions.

After some discussion on the matter of the Police Department Facility, the Board directed Town Attorney Scheinberg to prepare and submit resolutions, and plans, specifications and contract documents on the alterations for the Police Facility.

The Board also referred the review of the Meter Ordinance to the Town Attorney.

Justice Costello offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Zaloga.

RESOLVED, That the official undertaking in the amount of \$5,000, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of Malcolm Stewart as Constable, be and is hereby renewed, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of said Bond shall be filed in the Office of the Suffolk County Clerk, and one copy in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Justice Zaloga, Yes, Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Vojvoda, Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The request of the Wading River Group on use of tractor, location of boat ramp, and Pilings and Stringers, was discussed by the Board. It was decided that the Board would resolve this request and report to the Wading River Group before the boating season commences.

On the request of Zigmund Piliski desiring to rent space in the Jamesport Marina.

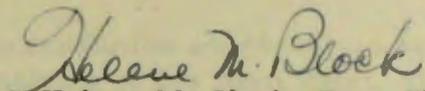
Supervisor Vojvoda appointed the following as a Committee: Justice Zaloga, Councilman Grodski and Supervisor Vojvoda, to determine rentals for boats desiring to rent space in the Jamesport Marina.

Justice Zaloga proposed that the Board give serious consideration to a Procedure on vacation time, sick leave and a schedule of summer hours, and that the schedule when compiled should include all employees in Town Departments.

Supervisor Vojvoda appointed the Members of the Town Board, as a Committee, to make a study and prepare a constructive Handbook on Employees Procedure for the Town of Riverhead.

Former Supervisor William J. Leonard addressed the Board and stated that after 21 years of sitting on the inside, he enjoyed sitting on the outside as an interested spectator. He extended good wishes to all the elected officials and wished them well during their terms in office.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned at 12:30 A. M., to meet on January 14, 1964 at 10:30 A. M.
